ANC SUBMISSION TO THEME COMMITTEE BLOCK 6 REPRESENTATIVE GOVERNMENT FRANCHISE AND SUFFRAGE AND CITIZENSHIP

1. REPRESENTATIVE GOVERN

- (a) There shall be regular elections for Parliament at least every 5 years has proportional and constituency representation in such a manner that the representation of parties in Parliament reasonably and equitably reflects their electoral support.. There shall be a common voters roll and universal adult suffrage.
- (b) The details of the percentage division between constituency and proportional representation is a matter to be spelt out in legislation.
- (c) The details of constituency definition is a matter of discussion under Theme Committee 2.

2.SUFFRAGE

There shall he multi-party democracy, regular elections and universal adult suffrage. The minimum voting age shall be determined through an act of parliament.

3. CITIZENSHIP:

All South Africans shall be entitled to equal citizenship, Full citizenship may be acquired by birth, decent, marriage or naturalisation. No citizen shall he arbitrarily deprived of h citizenship though legislation may set out circumstances in which citizenship shall be 10 Parliament shall not be prohibited from legislating for the extension of citizenship specified categories of people.
