The Executive Director proposed that the problem of the overlap of work between Theme Committees could be solved by the Core Groups or Technical Committees of the affected Theme Committees meeting to find a mechanism to resolve this.

With regard to the drafting of the report, the Executive Director was happy

to assist the Technical Committees with any administrative help.

The Executive Director confirmed that it was not necessary for the Report to be rewritten.

He also suggested that emotive items on the Theme Committee's agenda be dealt with as early as possible.

The Executive Director was excused at 12h15

The meeting authorised Corder and the Technical Experts to identify items where overlaps occur with other Theme Committees, to decide which other Theme Committees are involved and to report back to the Core Group.

The meeting also authorised Corder to get assistance for dealing with submissions.
