AN ACT to amend the Representation of the People Act.

[4th December, 2003]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Antigua and Barbuda as follows

1. This Act may be cited as the Representation of the People (Amendment)(No.3) Act, 2003 and shall be deemed to have come Into operation on the 1st October, 2003.

Short title.

2. Section 18 of the Representation of the People Act is amended by the deletion of subsection (1A) and the substitution of the following subsection:

Amendment of section 18 Cap.

- "(1A) The Commission shall, after the specified period referred to in subsection (1), cause to be prepared a register of electors for each constituency and thereafter the Commissionshall publish the register for each constituency as follows:
 - (a) in respect of the periodimmediately subsequent to the commencement of this subsection, the Commission shall publish the register not later than 15th November, 2003;

(b) after 15th November, 2003, the Commission shall publish the register in 2004 and in subsequent years at the intervals specified in subsection (1) of section 21."
