## (Revised schedule)

It would be appropriate to reschedule the works of the Constituent Assembly (CA) by also including the extended period: In view of the past experience it would be better to move ahead and finish the unfinished activities of constitution writing by not fixing the deadline now but by determining the timeline through the Business Advisory committee as and when it is required in order to complete the work as early as possible.

- 1. In place of the earlier plan in the beginning of the schedule, the following arrangements have been made. This CA works has been re-scheduled to finish the task of constitution writing in a total of 29 months or 126 weeks by deducting the period of five and a half month from the first meeting of the CA on 2065/2/25 (07 June 2008) and also by including the term of one year extended on 2067/2/14(28 May 2010), which will come into effect from 2065/8/1(16 November 2008)).
