

The basic principles for the Implementation Committee by the Speaker-

- (a) The committee shall hold a meeting once a week during regular sessions and once a month during the session breaks.
- (b) The committee shall review the following things-
  - (i) The prescriptions of the Chapter (12) Amending the Constitution primarily to less burden to the people, to raise the Pyidaungsu Hluttaw role, and to support the committee work.
  - (ii) Under the objective towards constitution which can build stability of the state, community peace and tranquility, development, to review the means to embrace current role of military into democratic structure.
  - (iii) Under the objective towards forever peace by building strong national conciliation, to carry out the amendments as appropriate relating with decentralization, self-administration and equal rights.
  - (iv) Under the objective towards accelerating democratic transition of people and the State, to perform the amendments if needed relating with the election system which is hybrid combining presidential and parliamentary system that can block democratic reform, presidential election which was designed as the chief minister election in parliamentary system, the prescriptions to resign from MPs and or opt out party activities to be appointed as president, vice presidents or union level administration.
  - (v) Following factors shall be included in the reviewing process:
    - (aa) Fundamental Rights of Citizens
    - (bb) Non-disintegration of the Union and National Reconciliation
    - (cc) Support towards peace
    - (dd) To appoint President, Vice President and or Union Level Administration officials from elected representatives for democracy process and unity.
- (c) The committee shall act toward federal democracy with the best interests of people and the State
- (d) The committee shall perform with the timeline to complete the bill for amendments before six months ahead 2015 election.
